E. M. C. Collection Report

The Every-Member Canvass Collection for the relief of our Synod's financial distress which was begun in the spring of this year has now reached the stage where almost all of our congregations have reported the results with which God has blessed their efforts up to date.

Although some have not quite finished their work and will continue with the collection and although a few have not yet been heard from, a report shall no longer be withheld from our congregations, especially since we have so many reasons to be thankful to God for His great blessings in this collection.

The question has often been asked: How much did the Every-Member Canvass Collection yield? — Here is your answer. All cash received by the District Treasurers of the Synod up to and including November 10 amounts to \$242,775.26. Then there are \$30,886.17 which we yet hope to receive. Part of this sum represents subscriptions which have already been paid, but being tied up temporarily in banks, could not yet be forwarded to the Treasurer; for the payment of the others a little more time must be granted. The total of cash received and all outstanding subscriptions to date amounts to \$273,661.43.

When we consider only the sum of \$242,775.26 already turned in, we certainly have reason to be very grateful that in these trying times our members have by sacrificing raised this very substantial amount of money.

But the figures alone do not express the full cause of our gratitude. Figures which may seem big to some, may seem small to others. In our collection someone might be tempted to say with dissatisfaction: We could just as well have made it \$500,000.00, if only all had worked with the same diligence and zeal.

Now, it is true that \$500,000.00 would have come closer to the needs of our Synod and that we actually could have done still better, had everyone been filled with greater fear and love of God. But we must remember, our Christians have not all the same zeal for our Savior's work. Such a condition will not obtain in this world. We are not all imbued with the same burning love for Christ and His kingdom, therefore we shall not be willing to make the same sacrifices in the service of our Lord. Because of this condition we must continually admonish, encourage, and strengthen one another.

The purpose of this report is to show why we should be grateful to God for granting us the sum of \$242,775.26. Remember the time in which this collection had to take place. It was a time when thousands were without work and without income; when many of our members suffered heavy losses, when banks failed and one structure after the other tumbled down to financial ruin; when many of our members had to take cuts in their pay and in their working hours so that they could hardly meet their expenses; a time when Satan was especially busy in tempting our Christians to cast aside their trust in the Lord and to give way to the sinful care of the flesh and to say: What is it all for? We must look out for ourselves first, we have nothing left for the kingdom of God. Shut down our synodical work until times get better.

Is it not a special grace of God that in spite of all these temptations and hardships our members gave so liberally and raised such a sum of money?

We would be still more grateful if the individual gifts of our Christians could speak to us. For, keep in mind that the total of \$242,775.26 is made up of the many small and large gifts from the thousands of our communicant members. Each gift has its own history, a history similar to that of Mary, of whom the Lord said: "Wher- ever this gospel shall be preached in the whole world, there shall also this, that this woman hath done, be told

for a memorial of her"; or that of the poor widow in the temple of Jerusalem of whom Jesus said: "She of her want did cast in all that she had, even all her living"; or that of the Macedonians, whom St. Paul in 2 Corinthians 8 holds up to us as shining examples.

If these individual gifts could speak to us, or if the Lord would reveal their history, as some of it has been revealed to us in communications from congregations, what a wonderful story it would be!

What joy would well up in our hearts similar to that which St. Paul experienced in his collection (2 Corinthians 8 and 9), if they could tell us of the ready willingness of our Christians to sacrifice; of their selfdenial for the Lord; of cases, where members deprived themselves of the necessities of life in order to help along in this collection; of such who considered Synod's needs as being equally as urgent as their own; who did not permit themselves to be hindered from giving liberally by the poor example of others or by the selfishness of their own flesh; if they could tell us of such members who have given \$100.00, \$200.00, \$500.00 or even more, not of their abundance, but as a sacrifice in spite of personal losses; or of the thousands of real needy members who took part in this work with such willingness, that it reminds us of what St. Paul writes 2 Corinthians 8, 2-4: "The abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality. For to their power, I bear record, yea, and beyond their power they were willing of themselves, praying to us that we would receive their gifts."

But the full history of these gifts, as of all good works, will remain hidden in this world, until our Lord Jesus will reveal it on Judgment Day, when He will publicly acknowledge them as testimonies of their faith and love, saying: "This ye have done unto me."

All of these beloved Christians we have in mind as we make this report and therefore add to our words those of St. Paul with which he closes the report on his collec-

tion, 2 Corinthians 9, 15: "Thanks be unto God for His unspeakable gift," for His grace and mercy which He showered upon us so abundantly without any merit or worthiness in us and through which He has made us willing to serve Him and gave us the power to fulfill His will.

To sum up this report on our collection: It is a testimony to the fact that love and gratitude are not dead among the members of our dear Synod.

* * * *

But now we must carry on the work assigned to us by the Lord in this same spirit. The Every-Member Canvass Collection was an emergency measure only to make up for what we failed to do in the past. Our regular collections for current expenses must not in any way be impaired by the Every-Member Canvass Collection. If we were to say, "We have exerted ourselves so much in that special collection that we can now sit back and take it easy," we would very soon find ourselves in the same deplorable financial condition as before. Whatever falls short of our budget in the festival and Sunday collections must again be added to our debt. This is exactly what has happened in the first three unusually lean months of this fiscal year, beginning July 1. A deficit of \$47,518.44 for July, August and September has been incurred.

Let us not lose sight of our chief work of maintaining our missions and institutions. God has blessed them so abundantly in the past. Let us hope and pray for future blessings.

Thanks to the willingness of our Christians to contribute towards this emergency collection we are not as yet forced to close any of our missions or institutions.

True, we had to shrink the work to a minimum. Wherever we could economize economies were effected. Our Board of Trustees carefully and prayerfully studied all expenditures in every department of our synodical work and used the knife wherever they could without jeopardizing the work of the Savior, and cut deeply into the salary of Synod's workers.

We, therefore, hope that we now will be able by means of our regular festival and Sunday collections not only to cover our reduced budget but also to wipe out the deficit accumulated in the first three months of this fiscal year.

But to accomplish this we must all work together. We dare not become weary in well-doing. The time of God's visitation is not yet past, our faith and love will be subjected to further trials and temptations. But one thing we cannot and will not forget at any time — our Lord Jesus Christ has redeemed us, purchased and won us that we should live under Him in His kingdom and serve Him. Let us serve Him to the best of our ability and with entire consecration to His cause. We pray God for His wonderful grace so that we may be found faithful stewards of His unmerited gifts.
